





The Hanover City Council special meeting was held January 16, 2020 at 5:00pm in the meeting room at the Firehouse at 201 S Railroad Street Hanover KS 66945.

Jared Sedlacek called the meeting to order at 5:05pm. Council members were Tony Bruna, Kylie Fritschi, and Don Spencer. Council members Nick Rohr and Kim Lohse arrived at 5:45pm. Employees present were Katlin Bruna. Guest included Britnee Snyder.

1. Britnee Snyder discussed her current utility bill.
2. Don made a motion, second by Kylie to raise the trash rate from \$14.25 to \$19.25. Motion carried.
3. Don made a motion, second by Tony to approve the Ordinance 683 (water), Ordinance 684 (sewer) and Ordinance 685 (trash). Motion carried.
4. Tony made a motion, second by Don to approve Ordinance 686, authorizing the purchase of water. Motion carried.
5. Discussion on citizens complaints about dogs in their neighborhood.
6. Tony made a motion, second by Kim to approve updating Scott's computer. Motion carried.
