The regular Hanover City Council meeting was held March 9, 2020 at 6:00pm in the meeting room at the Firehouse at 201 S Railroad Street Hanover KS 66945.

Mayor Jared Sedlacek called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Council members were Tony Bruna, Nick Rohr, Kim Lohse, and Kylie Fritschi. Council member Don Spencer came at 7:00pm. Employees present were Tim Koss, Scott Wieden, and Katlin Bruna. Guests included Robert Rut, Emily Benedick, Dustin Minge, and Darren Bruna.

- 1. Tony made a motion, seconded by Kim to approve February treasurer report. Motion carried.
- 2. Kylie made a motion, seconded by Kim to approve the regular and special meeting minutes from February. Motion carried.
- 3. Tony made a motion, seconded by Kylie to approve February expenses. Motion carried.
- 4. Robert Rut, Fire Chief, discussed the rent for the firehouse.
 - a. Nick made a motion, seconded by Tony to approve the rent for the firehouse be put in the fire fund account. Motion carried.
- 5. Robert Rut, Fire Chief, reported that there will be a pipeline meeting at 6:30pm on March 11; SCBA training March 21 from 1pm-5pm; and a storm spotters meeting in Washington March 24. The fire department only had one call in the month of February.
- 6. Emily Benedick, North Central Regional Planning Commission, discussed next steps for the water grant.
 - a. Kim made a motion, seconded by Kylie to approve the CDBG water grant agreement. Motion carried.
- 7. Dustin Minge, Blue Valley Insurance, discussed the renewal with EMC insurance.
 - a. Nick made a motion, seconded by Kylie to approve payment for the renewal with EMC insurance.
- 8. Darren Bruna, Hanover Township, discussed the agreement written up between the city and the township concerning maintenance of shared roads.
 - a. Don made a motion, seconded by Kim to approve the agreement between the city and the township. Motion carried.
- 9. Nick made a motion, seconded by Tony to go into executive session in the meeting room at 7:45pm for 5 minutes. Motion carried.
- 10. Tony made a motion, seconded by Don to come out of executive session in the meeting room at 7:50pm. Motion carried.

- 11. The council discussed the recent calls about having trash removed from utility bills. It was decided that if you have water/sewer on then trash will be on your utility bill.
- 12. Tony made a motion, seconded by Don to approve the purchase of 250 tons of coal mix. Motion carried.
- 13. Nick made a motion, seconded by Tony to approve Midwest Material hauling the city brush pile away for \$5700 plus \$700 to Darren Bruna for the use of his pasture. Motion carried.
- 14. Don made a motion, seconded by Kim to approve the purchase of two (2) new pool filters. Motion carried.
- 15. Don made a motion, seconded by Tony to recommend to the Hanover Chamber that B&W Electric installs the A/C units at the community building and Darrell Rohr for the maintenance. Nick abstained from voting; Kylie and Kim voted yes. Motion carried.
- 16. Nick made a motion, seconded by Tony to charge customers the Square fees when using the credit card machine. Motion carried.
- 17. The council discussed the summer applicants.
 - a. Kim made a motion, seconded by Tony to hire Rieken Stallbaumer for the ball field manager at \$30/field and \$9.00/hour with no more than 20 hours per week. Motion carried.
 - b. Kylie made a motion, seconded by Tony to hire Taeben Stallbaumer for the concession stand manager. Motion carried.
 - c. Kim made a motion, seconded by Tony to hire Robert Rut for city maintenance help at \$10/hour starting April 1, 2020 if needed. Motion carried.
- 18. The council discussed the repairs that need to be done at the Hanover Library.
- 19. The council discussed putting in water lines and connections east of Duis Auto for RV hook-ups for the carnival workers.
- 20. The council will meet March 23, 2020 at 6:30pm at the old City Hall and then move to the Firehouse meeting room at 7:00pm to discuss short term projects for water/sewer and street departments.
