

Hanover City Council Meeting

April 13, 2020 at 6:00pm

The regular Hanover City Council meeting was held April 13, 2020 at 6:00pm in the meeting room at the Firehouse at 201 S Railroad Street Hanover KS 66945.

Mayor Jared Sedlacek called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Council members were Tony Bruna, Nick Rohr, Kim Lohse, Kylie Fritschi and Don Spencer. Employees present were Tim Koss, Scott Wieden, and Katlin Bruna.

1. Kim made a motion, seconded by Don to approve the monthly and quarterly treasurer reports. Motion carried.
2. Don made a motion, seconded by Kylie to approve the regular March minutes and the March special meeting minutes. Motion carried.
3. Nick made a motion, seconded by Kim to pay the bill for the repairs at the Kloppenberg Center contingent on if the city sends funds the Kloppenberg each year. Motion carried.
4. Tony made a motion, seconded by Kylie to approve the expenditures as written with the addition of Core and Main, GWB, P.A, Bruna Implement, Kansas Gas, and Gary Willman. Motion carried.
5. Nick made a motion, seconded by Tony to approve Ordinance 687 Snow Removal on Private Property and Ordinance 688 Snow Removal on Streets. Motion carried.
6. Nick made a motion, seconded by Kim to approve the additional \$400.00 to the Midwest bid for cleaning out the dump site. Motion carried.
7. The council discussed the pool. It was decided to postpone discussion until next meeting to see what happens regarding COVID-19.
8. The council discussed utility bill concerns.
9. Tony made a motion, seconded by Don to go into executive session for ten (10) minutes at 7:10pm. Motion carried
10. Tony made a motion, seconded by Don to leave executive session at 7:20pm. Motion carried.
11. Don made a motion, seconded by Kim to give the street and water commissioners a raise starting April 1, 2020. Motion carried.
 - a. The street and water commissioner will work 40 hours/week with 3 hours overtime October-March and 40 hours/week with 8 hours overtime April-September.
 - b. The street commissioner will be at an hourly rate of \$19.00/hour and the water commissioner will be at a hourly rate of \$15.00/hour.
12. The council discussed the hiring of a pool manager and lifeguards. Tabled until next meeting.
13. Nick made a motion, seconded by Tony to hire Andrew Gugenhan for summer maintenance help.
14. Tony made a motion, seconded by Kim to pay Andrew \$9.50/hour. Motion carried.
15. The council discussed the installation of turf and sealing and painting the tennis courts. Tabled.
16. The council discussed COVID-19 and decided that the city office will be closed to the public until further notice.
17. The council discussed burning in town. Tabled.
18. The council discussed the Pet Clinic and Dog/Cat tags and decided to extend the registration due date for this year to July 1, 2020.
19. The council discussed road systems ideas for future grants.
20. Don made a motion, seconded by Kim to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
