

Hanover City Council Meeting

August 10, 2020 at 6:00pm

The regular Hanover City Council meeting was held August 10, 2020 at 6:00pm in the meeting room at the Firehouse at 201 S Railroad Street Hanover KS 66945.

Mayor Jared Sedlacek called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Council members were Tony Bruna, Nick Rohr, Kim Lohse, and Don Spencer. Council member Kylie Fritschi arrived at 6:40pm. Employees present were Tim Koss, Scott Wieden, and Katlin Bruna. Guests included Marcus Frese.

1. Nick made a motion, seconded by Don to approve the monthly treasurer report. Motion carried.
2. Nick made a motion, seconded by Kim to approve the monthly expenditures except Midwest Products which will be discussed later in the meeting. Motion carried.
3. Tony made a motion, seconded by Don to approve the July minutes. Motion carried.
4. Marcus Frese discussed with the council the 2021 Budget.
 - a. Tony made a motion, seconded by Kim to leave the regular meeting, and go into the 2021 budget public hearing at 6:30pm. Motion carried.
 - b. Nick made motion, seconded by Don to approve the 2021 budget. Motion carried.
 - c. Nick made a motion, seconded by Don to leave the 2021 budget public hearing, and return to the regular monthly meeting. Motion carried.
5. Robert Rut, Fire Chief, was unable to attend the meeting but the city clerk reported for him that the firehouse basement and gutters were still leaking; Fisher Rock was discussed and waiting to hear from the city attorney regarding questions on the situation; and burning in city limits was discussed.
6. Street Department
 - a. The council approved the street commissioner to purchase oil from Flint Hills and use the check made from at the end of 2019 to pay for the oil first.
 - b. The council discussed sidewalks in city limits being removed and not replaced. Tabled to find more information.
 - c. The council discussed the city dump site. Council asked the city clerk to write up some guidelines for the dump site.
 - d. The council discussed having a fall city wide clean up. Tabled.
7. Water/Sewer Department
 - a. The council discussed lining the sewer lines in the city limits. Tabled to gather more information.
 - b. The council discussed the lift stations in the city limits. Tabled to gather more information.
8. Pool Department
 - a. The council discussed the pool inspection being done by Paddock pool. Things included in the design that the council discussed are a new bathhouse, pumphouse, zero entry, and lap swimming.
9. Grant and Funding
 - a. Tony made a motion, seconded by Don to pull the CD at the bank that is due to help make payments towards the water project invoices. Motion carried.
10. Council
 - a. The council discussed the monies that have been used towards COVID-19 items.

- b. The council discussed the money that has been allocated to the city from the county for COVID-19 purposes. The council decided that they would use the money towards technology and PPE items.

11. Buildings and Properties

- a. The council discussed the responsibilities of the community building between the city and the chamber.
 - i. Mayor Jared Sedlacek appointed a new committee as the Building and Properties committee. The committee members will be Don, Kim, and Kylie with Don as head of the committee.
 - ii. The Buildings and Properties committee will meet with the chamber on Monday August 17, 2020 at 6pm
 - iii. Don made a motion, seconded by Tony to pay the Midwest Bill for rock for the community building. Motion carried.

12. Parks&Rec

- a. The council discussed having a workday at the ball fields on Saturday August 15, 2020. City clerk is to post on Facebook, website, and send by city text to let the city know.
- b. The council discussed the Parks and Rec Bylaws. Tabled.
- c. The council discussed work to be done at the tennis courts at Vet's Park. Tabled.

13. City Office

- a. Don made a motion, seconded by Tony to approve the beer licenses for the Little Blue Bar and Grill. Motion carried.
- b. Tony made a motion, seconded by Kylie to approve the city clerk to fax an ownership form to KS tax. Motion carried.
