

Hanover City Council Meeting
April 20, 2021 at 6:00pm

The special Hanover City Council meeting was held April 20, 2021 at 6:00pm at the Firehouse at 201 S Railroad St. Hanover KS 66945.

1. Scott Zaboktrsky, County Commissioner
 - a. The council discussed the budget and mill levy's with Scott Zaboktrsky.
 - b. The council also discussed with Scott when main street would be redone. The council recommended waiting until the Water Project is finished.
