### Welcome to Medicare Visits Offered at Hanover Hospital By Aubrie Schaefer, APRN-C

A welcome to Medicare Visit is a one time clinic visit that takes place within the first 12 months of a person being enrolled in Medicare. It's a visit where you sit down and have a one on one conversation with your provider and catch up on all the things that need caught up on. For people turning 65 and now having new healthcare coverage, it's a great time to review your health history, re-group and get a health plan in place! Adult vaccines? Let's figure it out! Family history of diabetes? Let's make a plan to screen. Colon/breast/prostate/lung cancer screenings? Let's schedule it! Curious about advanced directives? We have info on that!

For our patients who are turning 65 soon, or have turned 65 in the last 12 months, this is a great opportunity to come in and touch base with us and make sure you're caught up on all of your healthcare concerns. This visit is not the same thing as an annual physical exam—there are no tests done or blood draws at these visits. You will leave the visit with an individualized, written plan on when and how often tests and screenings are recommended.

This visit is completely covered by Medicare, with no co-pay or deductible to be met.

If you're an established patient of ours, and turning 65 soon, be on the lookout for a reminder card in the mail. If you're not an established patient, Dr. Linda Warren, Aubrie Schaefer, NP and our new nurse practitioner Jayda Edgar are happily accepting new patients and would love to help out!
