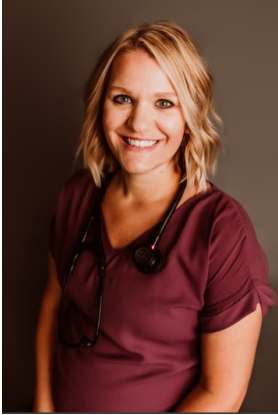
## City Project Updates

## Heart Health Month!

Happy Heart Health Month! Did you know every 36 seconds in the US, someone dies from heart disease? We talk about heart disease a lot in the medical field, but what exactly is heart disease? Well, it encompasses many different types of heart conditions that effects the blood flow to your heart such as coronary artery disease. Risk factors for heart disease include diabetes, being overweight, high cholesterol, high blood pressure, and smoking - just to list a few. So, how can you prevent and manage heart disease? The CDC has started a "million hearts" campaign in which the goal is to prevent 1 million heart attacks by 2027. One of the ways they plan to do this is to educate people on the ABCS of heart health. A stands for aspirin. Talk to your healthcare provider about taking an aspirin every day. B stands for controlling your blood pressure. Evidence currently shows that for most people, the closer to 120/80 is best. C is for managing your cholesterol. Cholesterol can build up in your arteries and cause heart disease thus increasing your risk for a heart attack or stroke.

S-stands for don't smoke. You can call 1-800-QUIT-NOW for more resources. Talk to your healthcare provider today about how you can lower your risk for heart disease!
