August is National Immunization Awareness Month By Aubrie Schaefer, MSN, APRN, FNP-C

Every year, in an effort to bring attention to the important role that vaccines play in preventing diseases, the CDC recognizes August as National Immunization Awareness Month. With the recent COVID pandemic, vaccines have gained a lot of attention, and unfortunately some of this has been negative attention. Discussions with your healthcare provider can help clear up any confusion that may have been caused by all of the recent hype.

Vaccines are important through all stages of life as they help provide immunity prior to being exposed to a potentially life-threatening illness. Vaccines are recommended for infants, preschoolers, teenagers, expectant mothers, young adults, middle aged adults, and the elderly—<u>everyone</u> benefits from vaccines. This article focuses on vaccines recommended in adulthood.

**COVID vaccine: Yes! Get it! And get boosted! It is proven to be safe and effective. The CDC keeps their website up to date with recommendations for all age groups. Ask your health care provider or vaccine provider for help with determining when you're due for your next vaccine.

**Influenza: Everyone 6 months and older should get this vaccine every year in the fall—preferably before the end of October.

**Shingles: This is recommended for adults aged 50 and over. Unfortunately, we sometimes have a hard time getting insurance to pay for this and it can be expensive. It's important to communicate with your provider to find ways to obtain this vaccine. Shingles infections can lead to permanent nerve damage, pain, and blindness. Most of us know someone who has suffered through a shingles infection—they can tell you, it's no joke!

Tetanus: Most people are great about coming in for a tetanus vaccine when they've suffered an injury, but this vaccine should actually be given every 10 years regardless of injury. This vaccine is often administered as a combo with the **pertussis vaccine--which is important to have if you plan to be around newborns as they cannot be vaccinated against whooping cough until they are 2 months old.

**Pneumonia vaccine: Adults aged 65 and older should have two different pneumonia vaccines. Some adults with certain health conditions like diabetes, heart disease, and cancer should be given this vaccine prior to turning 65.

As mentioned multiple times throughout this article, conversations with your healthcare provider are strongly encouraged to clear up any confusion and hesitation regarding vaccines.
