

City of Hanover Council Meeting: November 9, 2022 at 6:00pm

The Hanover City Council meeting was held November 9, 2022 at 6:00pm in the meeting room at the Firehouse at 201 S Railroad Street Hanover KS 66945.

Mayor Jared Sedlacek called the City of Hanover council meeting to order at 6:00pm. Council members present were Kim Lohse, Nick Garber, Scott Jueneman and Don Spencer. Council member Coby Sedlacek was absent. Employees present were Tim Koss, Scott Wieden, and Katlin Bruna. Employee Melissa Minge was absent. Guest included Chelsea Becker.

1. Treasurer's Report
  - a. Don made a motion, seconded by Kim to approve the monthly treasurer's report. Motion carried.
2. Expenditures
  - a. Don made a motion, seconded by Nick to approve the monthly expenditures. Motion carried.

  - e. Bids for Generator Plug—Tabled.
    - i. No bids turned in.
  - f. Dump Site Update
    - i. Send out bids for cleaning out the dump site.
    - ii. Discussion of adding a \$1 to utility bills to help with cost of cleaning out the dumpsite.

  - a. Water Commissioner and City Clerk working on the bid for remaining water meters to be put in. Tabled.
7. Community Building
  - a. Fire Suppression System. Tabled for further clarification.

  - a. Evaluations will be given to council for water commissioner and city clerk to review at the December meeting.
  - b. Discussion on the truck route with Farmer's Coop. Tabled to have meeting with Farmer's Coop.
