# NEWS FROM THE



RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus)

'Tis the season for Christmas cards, carols, and colds! You've probably heard quite a bit about RSV in the news the past several weeks. RSV is a common virus that is very contagious. RSV is the most common cause of lower respiratory tract infections in children less than 1 year old and can cause pneumonia, airway obstruction and even acute respiratory failure.

Symptoms of RSV may include a cough, runny nose, and red eyes. In our area, RSV outbreaks typically occur from October to May with a peak in January or February. RSV, like many other viruses, is spread through nasal and oral secretions. RSV can survive for several hours on hands.

Unfortunately, there is no vaccine for RSV. Therefore, hand washing, and cough hygiene (coughing into a tissue or sleeve) is so important to prevent outbreaks. Unfortunately, immunity is short-lived, so even if you or your loved one has had RSV this season, it is possible you may get it again.

There is a common myth that only babies get the virus, however that is entirely false. It is true however that infants, particularly those with other health conditions and those born prematurely, will usually become more symptomatic from the virus. So, even as adults if we do not have symptoms it is possible we are carrying the virus and may pass it on to those more vulnerable.
