The City of Hanover special meeting was held February 15, 2023 at 6:00pm in the meeting room at the Firehouse at 201 S Railroad Street Hanover KS 66945.

Mayor Jared Sedlacek called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Council members present were Kim Lohse, Nick Garber, and Don Spencer. Council members Coby Sedlacek and Scott Jueneman were absent.

1. Scott Zaboktrsky, County Commissioner
  - a. Scott and the council members discussed what Scott was able to find out at the county commissioners meeting regarding the taxes the city receives from the county.
